

# STONE CANYON OUTDOOR EDVENTURES-STUDENT PACKING LIST

In order for your child to be as comfortable and prepared as possible, please look over this packing list closely and adhere to the items and guidelines we have provided. Sudden changes in the weather are not uncommon, and as we believe outdoor education should be outdoors as much as possible, we want your child prepared! **Check the weather for Larkspur, CO for the week of your child's Outdoor Education retreat.**

**Please be sure that everything your child packs will fit into one suitcase/duffel bag (excluding their backpack).** This will help ensure that there are no space issues on the bus.

**We highly recommend putting your child's name on the italicized items on the checklist in the event that they are lost.**

## SNACKS

Students and families are no longer required to pack snacks or lunch for the first day! We now provide all meals throughout the trip, as well as snacks for all students. Although we are a peanut-free facility, should your student need to bring supplemental snacks for a food allergy, please communicate this with your student's teacher.

## MEDICATIONS

We adhere to the district policy in regards to the distribution of prescription medications. Any prescription medications must be sent in their original container with accurate labels, along with the prescription medication release signed by a physician; medications without the original container may NOT be administered. **ALL medications, prescribed or otherwise, are turned into our nurse.**

## CONTRABAND

The following items are **not** permitted. Should these items be brought to Stone Canyon, they will be collected and given to the school's teachers and/or administration attending the trip.

- Electronics, including but not limited to: cell phones, mp3 players, tablets, laptops, gaming systems
- Matches/lighters
- Pocket knives/multi-tools
- Candy
- Gum
- Aerosol sprays (perfume and deodorants)
- Over the counter medications
- Hair dryers and curling irons
